FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Decision No. 12,580 in the above entitled matter, provided with reference to the steam rates of Pacific Gas and Electric Company that such rates be subject to increase or decrease upon approval of this Commission on the basis of three cents per thousand pounds of steam for each ten cent increase or decrease respectively per barrel in the price of oil above or below the price in effect on August 1, 1923, and,

WHEREAS, Pacific Gas and Electric Company now makes affidavit that on September 22, 1925 the price of oil was decreased by thirty-five cents (35¢) per barrel as a result of which it will, until again changed, be thirty cents (30¢) per barrel above the price in effect August 1, 1923,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company reduce its present rates for steam so that they shall be nine cents (9¢) per thousand pounds greater than those fixed

in Decision No. 12,580, said reduction to become effective for all regular meter readings taken on and after October 22, 1925.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company file with this Commission on or before October 22, 1925 revisions of its schedule as herein authorized.
