FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission, following the granting to C. O. Bentley of a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automobile service for the transportation of passengers and express between Redwood City and Canyon Sanitarium, has twice extended the time within which C. O. Bentley was to start operation of said stage line, said extensions of time covering a period of approximately 6 months from the date of the Commission's order granting the certificate, namely, March 25, 1925, and

WHEREAS said C. O. Bentley, through his attorney, has advised the Commission, under date of October 5, 1925, that it is not his intention to operate said automobile service, and has asked that the certificate heretofore granted be revoked, therefore

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to C. O. Bentley by the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 14704, issued on Application No. 10876 be, and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
