ORDER OF DISMISSAL.

WHEREAS, California Fireproof Storage Company has filed a formal complaint against the Southern California Telephone Company, requesting this Commission to require the Southern California Telephone Company to accept from complainant and publish in the classified business section of its telephone directory certain advertising matter, at certain rates, and that said Southern California Telephone Company be ordered to charge and collect from complainant and other subscribers a certain rate for printing names in bold faced black type in said telephone directory, and that defendant be required to refund to complainant all amounts

in excess of the charge specified; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the action requested by complainant does not come within the jurisdiction of the Railroad Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the complaint herein be and the same is hereby dismissed for lack of jurisdiction.
