FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission by decision No. 14883, dated May 7, 1925, established rates to be charged by the Oak-dale Gas Company, and provided that such rates would be subject to increase or decrease on the basis of three (3) cents per thousand cubic feet of gas for each ten cent increase or decrease, respectively, in the price of oil above or below \$1.90 per barrel in Oakdale, and further provides that no increase shall be made after the price of oil F. O. B. Oakdale passes \$2.40 per barrel, and

WHEREAS, Oakdale Gas Company now makes affidavit that on October 12, 1925, the price of oil was decreased from \$1.90 per barrel to \$1.585 per barrel, making the present price of oil 31.5 cents below the base price established in Decision No. 14883.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Oakdale Gas Company reduce its rates, designated as schedule No. 1, effective for all regular meter readings taken on and after November 12, 1925, so that said rates shall be equal to nine cents less than the basic rates on file with the Commission as established in Decision No. 14883.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Oakdale Gas Company file with this Commission on or before November 10, 1925, a revision of its schedules to comply with this order.
