FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission, in a letter dated September 25, 1925, has been advised of the death of Geo. B. Long, operator of an automobile stage service between Susanville and Wendel, and

WHEREAS, the heirs of Geo. B. Long, in an affidavit filed with the Railroad Commission, have declared that the cancellation of the mail contract held by Geo. B. Long, and the consequent loss of revenue have made it impossible to operate said auto stage line between Susanville and Wendel at a profit, and

WHEREAS, said heirs of Geo. B. Long, have petitioned the Railroad Commission for authority to discontinue operation of said automobile stage line between Susanville and Wendel, therefore.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the heirs of Geo. B. Long be and the same hereby are authorized to discontinue the automobile service heretofore conducted by Geo. B. Long between Susanville and Wendel under authority of the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to said Geo. B. Long by the Railroad Commission in its Decision No.11759, dated March 6, 1923, issued on Application No.8352, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that said certificate of public convenience and necessity, heretofore granted in Decision No.11,759, be and the same hereby is revoked and annualled.
