SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, on October 5, 1925, the Railroad Commission of the State of California issued its order No. 15490, approving a certain wharf franchise more particularly described in said order; and

WHEREAS, in said order it was provided that such order should not become effective until W. W. Ward should file with this Commission, for approval, a stipulation declaring that neither he nor his assigns will ever claim before the Railroad Commission of the State of California nor any court or other public body any value for said wharf franchise in excess of the amount actually paid to the County of San Luis Obispo as a consideration for the granting of said wharf franchise, which amount was to be included in said stipulation; and,

WHEREAS, W. W. Ward has filed with this Commission

a stipulation in such character which this Commission now declares to be in form satisfactory to it;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Railroad Commission of the State of California hereby approves said stipulation and declares its said Order No. 15490 to be effective from this date forward.
