EIGHTE SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Whereas, in Decision No. 9125 (20 C.R.C. 64) in the above entitled matter, this Commission provided, with reference to the rates therein established, that such rates would be subject to increase or decrease by amounts as set forth therein, upon approval of the Railroad Commission, based upon a change in the price paid for oil in the various communities served; and

Whereas, Pacific Gas and Electric Company now makes affidavit that, as of October 27, 1925, the price paid for oil was decreased;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Pacific Gas and Electric Company decrease the rates for gas service, as determined in Decision No. 15512, effective for all meter readings taken on and after November 26, 1925, so that the rates of the several schedules shall be less than the basic rates of the respective schedules, set forth in Decision No. 9125, by the following amounts:

Schedule	G-1	12 cents per 1,000 cubic feet
"	G-3	16 cents per 1,000 cubic feet
"	G-4	13 cents per 1,000 cubic feet
"	G-5	15 cents per 1,000 cubic feet
"	G-6	15 cents per 1,000 cubic feet
"	G-7	18 cents per 1,000 cubic feet
"	G-8	22 cents per 1,000 cubic feet
"	G-9	15 cents per 1,000 cubic feet

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that Pacific Gas and Electric Company file with the Commission, on or before November 20, 1925, revisions of its schedules as herein authorized.
