BY THE COMMISSION:

FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, in Decision No. 11092 (22-C.R.C.-383) in the above entitled matter, this Commission provided with reference to Schedules "A" and "C" of San Joaquin Light and Power Corporation that such rates would be subject to decrease upon approval of the Railroad Commission on the basis of three (3) cents per thousand cubic feet for each ten (10) cents decrease in the cost of oil below the price of \$1.97 per barrel F. O. B. Selma and \$2.00 per barrel F. O. B. Merced; and,

WHEREAS, the San Joaquin Light and Power Corporation subsequently filed with this Commission Schedule "D" effective on May 1, 1925, under Special Permit No. 250416-109-G, subject to increase or decrease of one and one-half ( $1\frac{1}{2}$ ) cents per thousand cubic feet for each ten (10) cents increase or decrease in the cost of oil above or below the price of \$1.40 F. O. B. Bakersfield, but in no instance less than eighteen (18) cents per thousand cubic feet; and,

WHEREAS, San Joaquin Light and Power Corporation now

makes affidavit that on October 27, 1925, the price paid for oil was decreased to \$1.45 per barrel F. O. B. Merced, \$1.42 per barrel F. O. B. Selma and 90 cents per barrel F. O. B. Bakersfield;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that San Joaquin Light and Power Corporation decrease its present rates designated as Schedules "A", "C" and "D" effective for all meter readings taken on and after November 26, 1925, so that said rates designated as Schedules "A" and "C" shall be sixteen (16) cents per thousand cubic feet less than the basic rates established in Decision 11092, and Schedule "D" shall be three (3) cents per thousand cubic feet less than the basic rate filed with this Commission under Special Permit No. 250416 - 109 - G.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that San Joaquin Light and Power Corporation file with the Commission on or before November 20, 1925, revisions of its schedules as herein authorized.
