OPINION AND ORDER ON PETITION FOR REHEARING

On petition for rehearing made by respondents, this proceeding was reopened for the purpose of oral argument as to our finding that the increased less than carload rating of one and one-half times first class on Radio Receiving Sets and Talking Machines and Radio Sets Combined, proposed by respondents, was not justified. Oral argument was presented by all interested parties October 27, 1925.

Now, upon further consideration of Decision No. 15305 of August 18, 1925 and of the record in the above entitled proceeding, in the light of the argument we conclude to affirm our

original finding; Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the said order of August 18, 1925, in Decision No. 15305, remain in full force and effect.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the effective date of Decision No. 15305, originally set for August 25, 1925 and which by second supplemental order was extended until further order of the Commission, is hereby further amended, making the effective date of the Decision and Order December 1, 1925.
