BY THE COMMISSION:

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission by Decision No. 14882, dated May 7, 1925, established rates to be charged by the Cakdale Gas Company and provided that such rates would upon order of the Railroad Commission be subject to increase or decrease on the basis of three (3) cents per thousand cubic feet of gas for each ten (10) cents increase or decrease, respectively, in the price of oil above or below \$1.90 per barrel in Cakdale, and further provided that no increase shall be made after the price of oil f.o.b. Cakdale passes \$2.40 per barrel; and,

WHEREAS, Oakdale Gaz Company now makes affidavit that on October 27, 1925, the price of oil was decreased from \$1.90 per barrel to \$1.485 per barrel, making the present price of oil 41.5 cents per barrel below the base price established in Decision No. 14883;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Oakdale Gas Company reduce its rates, designated as Schedule No. 1, effective for all meter readings taken on and after November 26, 1925, so that said rates shall be equal to twelve (12) cents per thousand cubic feet less than the basic rates on file with the Commission as established in Decision No. 14883.

IT IS HERREY FURTHER ORDERED, that Oakdale Gas Company

file with the Commission on or before November 26, 1925, a revision of its schedules as herein ordered.
