FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Wheeler's Hot Springs Stage Line, Murray D. Bayless, owner, engaged in the business of transporting persons and property between Los Angeles and Wheeler's Hot Springs, with service to certain intermediate points under a certificate granted by the Railroad Commission in Decision No. 15321, dated August 18, 1925, and issued on Application No. 10585, has, in a supplemental application, petitioned the Railroad Commission for authority to discontinue the year-round service authorized in said certificate and to substitute therefor a seasonal operation, and

WHEREAS, said Murray D. Bayless, owner of Wheeler's Hot Springs Stage Line, claims, in justification of his supplemental petition, that there is not sufficient travel in the winter months to make his operation profitable during the period between November 1st and May 1st of each year, now, therefore,

Good cause appearing and the Commission being fully advised,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted by the Railroad Commission to Wheeler's Hot Springs Stage Line, Murray D. Bayless, owner, be and the same hereby is amended to provide for service only between May 1st and November 1st of each year, the order in Decision No. 15321, in all other respects to remain unchanged, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that for the year 1925,
service may be discontinued within five (5) days from date
of the supplemental order herein.
