South Park Water Company having applied to the Railroad Commission for permission to issue \$90,000. of bonds for the purpose of providing funds to finance the cost of acquiring the Morgan Water Plant and to pay for extensions and improvements, a public hearing having been held before Examiner Williams, and applicant, subsequent to the hearing, having reported that it has modified its plans, and having filed its application No. 11827 in which it asked for and received permission to issue \$125,000. of bonds for the purposes, among others, for which it desired to issue the \$90,000. of bonds, and the Commission being of the opinion that this application should be dismissed without prejudice,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled matter be, and it is hereby, dismissed without prejudice.
