SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Whereas the Railroad Commission, in its Decision No. 14708, ordered that Huntington Beach Telephone Company, a corporation, charge and collect certain rates as set forth therein in Exhibit No. 1 after approval by Supplemental Order, which approval, as stated in said decision, should not be given until after satisfactory showing that applicant, Huntington Beach Telephone Company, had properly rebuilt its telephone plant to render adequate service, and

Whereas the Railroad Commission has evidence to the effect that Huntington Beach Telephone Company has complied with the conditions of the order in Decision No. 14708, dated March 27, 1925.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Huntington Beach Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to publish, file and make effective the schedules of rates as set forth in Exhibit No. 1 of this Commission's Decision No. 14708 on and after January 1, 1926, providing such schedules of rates together with such revised maps as

may be necessary be submitted for filing with this Commission on or before December 31, 1925.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
