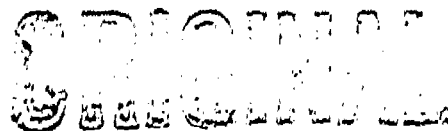


Decision No. 15750.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of Southern California Telephone Company for an order authorizing exchange areas in the territory served; authorizing the introduction of measured service, and authorizing just and reasonable rates, together with rules and regulations appertaining thereto for the territory served.

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 14,420, dated December 31, 1924, the Railroad Commission fixed the location of the Exchange area boundary line between the Los Angeles and Culver City Exchanges of the Southern California Telephone Company.

It now appears that, in order to facilitate administration of service requirements by the Southern California Telephone Company, it is advisable to relocate a certain portion of this boundary line as shown in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern California Telephone Company shall relocate that portion of its Los Angeles - Culver City Exchange Area boundary line as shown in Exhibit "A", attached hereto, providing a map showing this change is submitted for filing with the Railroad Commission on or before December 31, 1925.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 14,420 dated December 31, 1925 shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this
First Supplemental Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after
the date hereof.
