O R D E R

WHEREAS, Reedley Telephone Company, having filed an Application with this Commission, requesting authority to file and place in effect a charge of five (5) cents for each local message made from public pay stations which it has established throughout its territory, and

WHEREAS, the rendering of public pay station service will be in the interest of the subscribers of Reedley Telephone Company and to the public and it appearing that applicant's request is reasonable and that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Reedley Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to charge the rate of five (5) cents for each local message made from public telephone stations on and after January 1, 1926, providing said rate be filed with

this Commission on or before December 31, 1925.
