OPINION and ORDER**ORIGINAL**

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a freight loading platform now located at Orange Avenue on applicant's Covina Line in the County of Los Angeles, said platform being 12 feet by 16 feet in size and located as shown in yellow color on a blue print map marked "C.E.R. 9476" as attached to the application herein.

Applicant alleges that the loading platform proposed to be abandoned is so located as to obscure the view of persons traveling south on Orange Avenue and thus tends to create a hazard of accident at the intersection of Orange/<sup>Avenue</sup> and the Covina Line of applicant; that the freight platform has not been used for several years last past and there is no prospect for future public use of said platform at its present location.

Applicant proposes to rehabilitate and reestablish the platform at a point on its Covina Line near Ethel Avenue where shipments destined to applicant's Ramona Section Camp are unloaded three times per week and which shipments require to be sheltered and protected from weather.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon and remove the freight loading platform now located at Orange Avenue on its Covina Line, in the County of Los Angeles, and to rehabilitate and reconstruct said platform at or near the intersection of Ethel Avenue with said Covina Line.
