SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Whereas the Railroad Commission, in its Decision No. 15,073, ordered that Fall River Valley Telephone Company charge and collect certain rates as set forth therein in Exhibit No. 1 after approval by Supplemental Order, which approval, as stated in said decision, should not be given until after satisfactory showing that applicant, Fall River Valley Telephone Company, had completed certain re-arrangements, construction and installations including establishment of central office switchboards at McArthur, Fall River Mills and Glenburn; construction of toll circuits, having no connected subscribers' stations, between McArthur and Fall River Mills, McArthur and Glenburn, and Glenburn and Fall River Mills; and completion of re-arrangements necessary to provide each subscribers' station with local exchange service from one central

office only, and

Whereas the Railroad Commission has evidence to the effect that Fall River Valley Telephone Company has complied with the conditions in the Order in Decision No. 15,073, dated June 20, 1925,

Company be and it is hereby authorized to publish, file and make effective the schedules of rates as set forth in Exhibit No. 1 of this Commission's Decision No. 15,073 on and after March 15, 1926, together with definitions, rules and regulations governing telephone service similar to those definitions, rules and regulations contained in this Commission's Decision No. 13,478 and as may be approved by this Commission:

Providing such schedules of rates and rules and regulations, together with such map or maps as may be necessary, be submitted for filing with this Commission on or before March 1, 1926.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
