OPINION and ORDER

Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a freight and passenger depot located at Brighton Beach, Terminal Island, on its San Pedro Branch in Los Angeles County.

Applicant alleges that neither freight nor passenger business has been transacted at the station of Brighton Beach during the past twelve months; that for a period of years the maintenance of the station has not been necessary for the business of the applicant or the service of the public; and that for the reason that public convenience and necessity does not require its continued maintenance it is applicant's desire to remove and abandon the station and conserve the expense required to maintain it.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon and remove its non-agency station of Brighton Beach on Terminal Island, Los Angeles County, on its San Pedro Branch, and

to eliminate said station name from its station records.
