FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, J. J. Mc Donald and Bert Mizer, co-partners and operators of an automobile service for the transportation of passengers and freight between Needles and a point on the California-Nevada state line on the Needles-Searchlight highway, which service was established under authority of the Railroad Commission as shown by its Decision No. 14563, dated February 14, 1925, and issued on Application No. 10528, having filed a financial statement with the Commission showing an out-of-pocket loss of \$76.59 resulting from operation during the months of May and June, 1925, and

WHEREAS, J. J. Mc Donald and Bert Mizer, co-partners, having filed a request, in connection with said financial statement, for authority to discontinue said service.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said request be granted and that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Mc Donald and Mizer in Decision No. 14563, be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
