ORDER OF DISMISSAL

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application No. 12246 for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an auto trucking service between

Los Angeles and points within a radius of 15 miles of Los Angeles on the one hand and points within a radius of 75 miles of Los Angeles on the other hand
