OPINION and ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment of the non-agency station of Flowerfield on its Stockton Division in San Joaquin County.

Applicant alleges that Flowerfield is located within the yard limits of its station of Tracy; that no passenger business was transacted at said station during the year ending November 30, 1925; and that the proposed abandonment of station name does not involve the abandonment of any facilities and will not affect the service now afforded to industrial spur tracks in the vicinity of said station.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Flowerfield in San Joaquin County on its Stockton Division and to eliminate the name of Flowerfield from its station records.
