ORDER OF DISMISSAL.

WHEREAS, the applicant in the above entitled pro-
ceeding has not taken advantage of opportunity offered by the
Railroad Commission and amended said application by substitu-
ting for the operation herein proposed, a service between fixed
termini or over a regular route or routes, thus bringing said
application within the meaning of the Auto Stage and Truck
Transportation Act, and

WHEREAS, said applicant has been duly advised by the
Railroad Commission under date of February 4, 1926, that unless
said amendment was filed within a period of thirty (30) days
thereafter said application would be dismissed without prejudice
for the reason that the Commission's jurisdiction does not cover
the character of service herein proposed in that the service is
not proposed to be conducted "between fixed termini or over a
regular route,"

Now, therefore, good cause appearing,
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED this application be and the same
hereby is dismissed without prejudice.
