Railroad Commission under date of February 3, 1926 that unless said amendment was filed within a period of thirty (30) days thereafter said application would be dismissed without prejudice for the reason that the Commission's jurisdiction does not cover the character of service herein proposed in that the service is not proposed to be conducted "between fixed termini or over a regular route".

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED this application be, and the same hereby is dismissed without projudice.
