ORDER OF DISMISSAL

WHEREAS, the applicant in the above entitled proceed-  
ing has not taken advantage of opportunity offered by the Rail-  
road Commission and amended said application by substituting  
for the operation herein proposed, a service between fixed ter-  
mini or over a regular route or routes, thus bringing said ap-  
plication within the meaning of the Auto Stage and Truck Trans-  
portation Act, and

WHEREAS, said applicant has been duly advised by the  
Railroad Commission under date of February 5, 1926, that unless  
said amendment was filed within a period of thirty (30) days  
thereafter said application would be dismissed without prejudice  
for the reason that the Commission's jurisdiction does not cover  
the character of service herein proposed in that the service is

not proposed to be conducted "between fixed termini or over a regular route",

Now, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED this application be and the same hereby is dismissed without prejudice.
