Lindsay Home Telephone and Telegraph Company, a corporation, having applied to the Railroad Commission for permission to issue a three year seven percent note in the principal amount of \$10,000. for the purpose of refunding an outstanding three year seven percent note for like amount which was issued pursuant to authority granted by the Commission by Decision No. 11813 dated March 19, 1923, and the Railroad Commission being of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted as herein provided,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Lindsay Home Telephone and Telegraph Company be, and it is hereby, authorized to issue its promissory note in the principal amount of \$10,000. payable on or

before three years after date with interest at not exceeding seven percent per annum for the purpose of refunding the note now outstanding which was issued pursuant to authority granted by the Commission by Decision No. 11813 dated March 19, 1923.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the authority herein granted shall become effective upon the date hereof and that applicant shall file with the Commission within thirty (30) days after the issue of the note herein authorized, a report as required by the Railroad Commission's General Order No. 24, which order in so far as applicable is made a part of this order.
