

Decision No. 16442

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of J. D. WEAST for certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automobile freight service over the public highways connecting with public highway or highways over which applicant now holds a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automobile stage route for a distance of fifty miles on such connecting roads or highways or to the nearest point now covered by an existing franchise.
