OPINION and ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the discontinuance of its non-agency station of Crescent on the San Bruno Branch of its Coast Division in the County of San Francisco.

Applicant alleges that the non-agency station of Crescent is located within the yard limits of San Francisco and that in its opinion the further maintenance of the station is not required for the convenience of the public and for the business of applicant.

No passenger business has been transacted at this station during the year ending December 31, 1925, no tariff fares being published to or from such station. No less than carload freight has been handled by applicant at this station during the year ending December 31, 1925, and the carload freight has been entirely crushed rock forwarded and principally road material received all for the account of the Raisch Improvement Company.

In view of the fact that this station is located within the yard limits of applicant's San Francisco station and that billing and other accounting for carload freight business will hereafter be handled at said San Francisco station, we are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon and discontinue its non-agency station at Crescent on the San Bruno Branch of its Coast Division in San Francisco County, and to eliminate said station name from its station records.
