OPINION and ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station at Ruric on its Western Division in Santa Clara County.

Applicant alleges that the non-agency station of Ruric is located within the switching limits of the yard of its San Jose station; that neither passenger nor freight business was transacted at said station during the yearly period ending January 31, 1926; that no passenger fares are published which are applicable to or from said station; and that in the opinion of applicant the further maintenance of Ruric as a non-agency station is not required by the applicant or its patrons.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Ruric on its Western Division in Santa Clara County, and to eliminate said station name from its station records.
