
Decision No. 16503

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of G. S. MAY operating under the fictitious name of MAY TRANSFER & STORAGE COMPANY for certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate automobile freight service between Modesto and ranches, farms and towns located within a radius of 50 miles of Modesto, for the transportation of farm products and general merchandise, AND

In the Matter of the Application of G. S. MAY operating under the fictitious name of MAY TRANSFER & STORAGE COMPANY for certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate automobile freight service for the transportation of grain from ranches located within approximately 20 miles of Tarkey Station and stations used for loading, along the Sacramento Northern Railroad, Sacramento River and Southern Pacific Railroad, operations to be seasonal during grain crop, each year.

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

G. S. May, operating under the fictitious name of May
Transfer & Storage Company, has petitioned the Railroad Commission
for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity re quire the operation by him of an auto trucking service between
Modesto and ranches within a radius of 50 miles thereof and be tween ranches within 20 miles of Tarkey station and rail points,
not named.

Public hearings were conducted by Examiner Satterwhite at Modesto and the matter was aukmitted. Under date of March 9,1926, the Railroad Commission advised the applicant, in writing, that

the service proposed was not an operation within the meaning of the Auto Stage and Truck Transportation Act in that it was not an operation between fixed points or over a regular route proutes, and that unless within 30 days, said application was amended so as to propose a service within the purview of the Act, it would be dismissed without prejudice. The 30 days have elapsed, and no amendment has been filed.

Now, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is dismissed without prejudice.
