being cared for by other certificated carriers, has requested that  
the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore  
granted him be annulled,

Now, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience  
and necessity heretofore granted in Decision No. 15551 be, and the  
same hereby is revoked and annulled.
