OPINION and ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment of two spur tracks located at Ball Station in the City of Freeno, Fresno County, on applicant's San Joaquin Division, said tracks being more definitely shown in yellow color on a blueprint map marked "S.J. No.7351-B", as attached to and forming a part of the application herein.

Applicant alleges that the tracks herein proposed to be removed were constructed several years ago for use as industrial tracks; that they are not now used to serve any industry or the public; and that applicant has recently acquired the land upon which the tracks are located and upon which land it is proposed to establish drill and industrial trackage in locations which require the removal of the spur tracks.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon and remove the two certain spur tracks now located at its station of Ball in the City of Fresno, County of Fresno, on its San Joaquin Division, the location of said tracks being shown in
