BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, a corporation, for an order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California approving a certain agreement entered into by and between applicant and C. S. MALTBY, dated March 15, 1926.

This is an application of Pacific Gas and Electric Company for an Order approving a contract entered into with C. S. Maltby covering the construction of an electric line extension and the supply of electric power therefrom. The consumer will use the electric power for mining operations in sparsely settled mountainous country, some distance from the nearest existing distribution line and it is estimated that the line extension will cost approximately \$42,750.00. The contract is for a term of ten (10) years instead of three (3) and guarantees the Company a gross revenue during the first five (5) years equal to the actual cost of the line. In all other respects the conditions of service and rate are in accordance with the standard practices of the Company.

These two special conditions are satisfactory to the

consumer and under all of the circumstances appear to be reasonable.

A public hearing on the matter does not seem necessary.

ORDER

Pacific Gas and Electric Company having applied to the Railroad Commission for an Order approving a certain agreement entered into by and between applicant and C. S. Maltby dated March 15, 1926, the Commission having considered the matter, and being of the opinion that said agreement should be approved and that a public hearing is not necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the above mentioned agreement between Pacific Gas and Electric Company and C. S. Maltby be and the same is hereby approved.
