<u>o p i n i o n</u>

Pacific Gas and Electric Company asks that the Railroad Commission approve an agreement between applicant and Joshua Hendy Iron Works covering the supplying of gas for industrial uses at a rate other than as provided in filed schedules. The rate applying in the locality in which this consumer is located also applies in a large number of small towns and suburban districts, many of which are supplied from small gas plants where transportation costs result in comparatively high prices of fuel oil. The Joshua Hendy Iron Works will be supplied by transmission from a comparatively efficient gas plant and in this case the large quantities of gas to be consumed can be sold profitably at a lower rate than provided in the schedule. Except for a minimum charge of \$50.00 per month the contract rate is the same as the schedule up to a consumption of approximately \$130. per month. The prospect of other consumers of the same class in the immediate vicinity does not justify the filing of a special schedule nor do the costs of production obtaining in many localities where the present schedule applies justify a reduction. This does not appear to be a matter

in which a public hearing is necessary.
