

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of LAKE TAHOE RAILWAY and TRANSPORTATION COMPANY for permission to sell and transfer to TAHOE TRANSPORTATION COMPANY, the right or permit to operate an automobile stage line, as a common carrier of persons and property, for compensation, between Tahoe City and Brockway, California, and intermediate points, and the right and permit to operate an automobile stage line as a common carrier of persons, for compensation, between Tahoe City and Pomins, California, and intermediate points, and of Tahoe Transportation Company to purchase and acquire the said rights or permits.

OPINION and ORDER

Lake Tahoe Railway and Transportation Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order approving the sale and transfer by it to Tahoe Transportation Company, a corporation, of

1- An operating right for an automobile service for the transportation of passengers between Tahoe City and Pomins and intermediate points as follows: Tahoe Pines, Homewood, Mc Kinneys, Moana Villa and Tahoma.

2- An operating right for the transportation of persons between Tahoe Tavern and Brockway and the following intermediate points: Tahoe City, Cornelian Bay and Tahoe Vista; also a right to transport express matter on passenger cars, subject to a limitation of 40 pounds per package, to and between Tahoe Tavern and Brockway and intermediate points,

and Tahoe Transportation Company, a corporation, asks for authority to purchase and acquire said operating rights and to hereafter operate thereunder.

The compensation to be paid for the property herein proposed to be transferred is given as the nominal sum of \$1.

The operating rights herein proposed to be transferred, namely, between Tahoe City and Pomins and intermediate points and between Tahoe Tavern and Brockway and intermediate points, were granted to Lake Tahoe Railway and Transportation Company, a corporation, one of the applicants herein, by the Railroad Commission in Decision

No.15059, dated June 15, 1925, and issued on Application No.10931, and Decision No.15061, dated June 15, 1925, and issued on Application No.10987.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1- The consideration to be paid for the property herein authorized to be transferred shall never be urged before this Commission or any other rate fixing body as a measure of value of said property for rate fixing, or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

2- Applicant Lake Tahoe Railway and Transportation Company shall immediately withdraw tariff of rates and time schedules on file with the Commission covering service, certificate for which is herein authorized to be transferred. Such withdrawal to be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No.51.

3- Applicant Tahoe Transportation Company shall immediately file in duplicate in its own name tariff of rates and time schedules which shall be identical with the rates or time schedules now on file with the Railroad Commission in the name of the Lake Tahoe Railway and Transportation Company, or rates and schedules satisfactory in form and substance to the Railroad Commission.

4- The rights and privileges herein authorized may not be sold, leased, transferred nor assigned, nor service thereunder discontinued, unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such sale, lease, transfer, assignment or discontinuance has first been secured.

5- No vehicle may be operated by applicant Tahoe Transportation Company unless such vehicle is owned by said applicant or is leased under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.

6- The authority herein granted is not to be construed as in any way authorizing the linking up of the rights transferred, or the establishment of through service over said rights.
