

held that it had no certificating jurisdiction over any auto transportation service other than a service between fixed points or over a regular route.

Theodore L. Stuart, Attorney for the applicant herein, after having been granted an extension of time to enable him to determine whether he would amend the application herein so as to propose a service between fixed points or over a regular route requested the Railroad Commission under date of April 28, 1926, to dismiss said application without prejudice.

Now, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is dismissed without prejudice.
