OPINION and ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Asylum on its Stockton Division in San Joaquin County.

Applicant alleges that the non-agency station of Asylum is located within the switching limits of Stockton Yard; that no freight business was transacted at said station during the year ending February 28, 1926; that no passenger business was transacted at said station during the year ending January 51, 1926, and that no tariff fares are published to or from said Asylum Station; and that the abandonment of the station will not involve the abandonment of any facilities.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS MEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon its non-agoney station of Asylum on its Stockton Division in San Joaquin County and to climinate said station name from its station records.
