OPINION and ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Wesby on its Stockton Division in Fresno County.

Applicant alleges that the non-agency station herein sought to be abandoned is located within the switching limits of Fresno Yard; that no freight business was transacted at said station during the year ending February, 1926; that no passenger business was transacted at said station during the year ending January, 1926; that the continued maintenance of the station is not necessary in that the abandonment of the station will not involve the abandonment of any facilities.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon its non-agency of Wesby on its Stockton Division in Fresno County and to eliminate said station name from its station records.
