ORDER OF DISMISSAL

McClintock Storage Warehouse Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by it of a motor truck transportation service within a radius of fifty miles from the city of San Diego, California.

A public hearing herein was conducted by Examiner Williams at San Diego on April 30. 1926, and applicant having been previously advised that the service proposed in the application was not an operation within the meaning of the Auto Stage and Truck Transportation Act in that it was not an operation between fixed termini or over a regular route or routes, and continuances having been granted on January 26 and March 25 for the purpose of permitting applicant to amend its application herein; and applicant now at the time of final hearing refusing to make further amendment to its application so as to bring it within the jurisdiction of this Commission;

Now, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application herein be and the same hereby is dismissed for want of jurisdiction.
