FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

San Francisco - Sacramento Railroad Company, a corporation, applicant herein, having on February 8th, 1926, made written request for a modification of Condition (2) of Decision No. 15620, dated November 7, 1925 in accordance with map (L-458-a) submitted on May 21, 1926, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, and that the request is reasonable and should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Condition (2) of said Decision No. 15620, reading as follows

(2) Said crossing shall be constructed equal or superior to type shown as Standard No. 2 in General Order No. 72 of this Commission and shall be constructed of a width to conform to that portion of said County Read No. 441, now graded, with the tops of rails flush with the readway and at the same level as the main line rails and with grades of approach not exceeding seven (7) per cent; shall be protected by a suitable crossing sign, and shall in every way be made safe for the passage thereover of vehicles and other road traffic.

be and it is hereby modified to read as follows.

(2) Said crossing shall be constructed equal or superior to type shown as Standard No. 2, in General Order No. 72 of this Commission and shall be constructed of a width to conform to that portion of said County Roads, No. 441 now graded, with the tops of rails not more than 1.2 feet below elevation of main line rails and flush with the roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding seven (7) per cent; shall be protected by a suitable crossing sign and shall in every way be made safe for the passage thereover of vehicles and other road traffic.

In all other respects this Commission's Decision No. 15620, dated November 7, 1925, in the above entitled proceeding shall remain in full force and effect.
