ORDER REVOKING PRIOR ORDER AND DISMISSING APPLICATION

Applicant herein, having in Application No. 12,850, filed on May 17, 1926, petitioned for authority to construct a spur track at grade across Stockton Street in the City of Lodi, County of San Joaquin, California, to take the place of one previously granted in this proceeding by Decision No. 8,995, dated May 21, 1921, and applicant having advised the Commission in said Application No. 12,850 that it desires to remove the spur track granted by said Decision No. 8,995 from Stockton Street, and it appearing to the Commission that said Decision No. 8,995, dated May 21, 1921, should therefore be revoked and this application dismissed, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Decision No. 8,995, dated May 21, 1921, be and it is hereby revoked and Application No. 6,820 be and it is hereby dismissed.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the spur track crossing of Stockton Street granted in said Decision No. 8,995 be removed from said street by applicant and the street repaired to conform to the adjacent sections thereof, placed in good and first class

condition for the use of the public.
