SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Lee D. Berdell, to whom the Railroad Commission in its Decision No.13527, dated May 7, 1924, and issued on Application No.10010, granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automobile service for the transportation of freight between Raymond and Oakhurst, has advised the Commission, in writing, under date of June 7, 1926, that business does not justify further operation of the service and that he desires an order of the Commission cancelling his certificate,

Now, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Lee D. Berdell by the Railroad Commission in its Decision No.13527 be, and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
