OPINION and ORDER

ORIGINAL

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Eastlawn on its Sacramento Division in Sacramento County.

Applicant alleges that the station herein proposed to be abandoned is located within the switching limits of Sacramento Yard; that neither freight nor passenger business has been transacted at said station during the year ending February, 1926; that the abandonment of the station will not result in the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of the applicant, there is no necessity for the continued maintenance of such non-agency station.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to discontinue the maintenance of its non-agency station of Eastlawn on its Sacramento Division in Sacramento County and to eliminate said station name from its station records.
