<u>ORDER</u>

Western States Gas and Electric Company and Pacific Gas and Electric Company having applied to the Railroad Commission for authority for the former to sell and the latter to purchase for the sum of Eighty-five Thousand (\$85,000) Dollars, a certain 60,000-volt electric transmission line running from the vicinity of Valley Spring to Altaville, and the Commission being apprised of the facts in the case and being of the opinion that the sale of said line will in no way interfere with the service of Western States Gas and Electric Company to its electric consumers, and that the purchase of said line will be beneficial to Pacific Gas and Electric Company, and other good cause appearing:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that

(1) Western States Gas and Electric Company be and it is authorized to sell and Pacific Gas and Electric Company to purchase for the sum of Eighty-five Thousand (\$85,000) Dollars that certain 60,000-volt electric transmission line and pertinent

rights-of-way, all more particularly described in the form of agreement attached to and made a part of the application in this matter.

(2) The price at which the transfer herein authorized is permitted to be made shall never be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of the value of the property transferred.

(3) The authority herein granted shall be effective from and after the date of this decision and shall apply to such transfer as may be made on or before September 1, 1926.
