OPINION and ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Enwood in Placer County on its Sacramento Division.

Applicant alleges that this station is located within the switching limits of the Roseville station yard; that no passenger or less than carload freight business was handled at this station during the yearly period ending February 28, 1926; that no passenger fares are published to or from said station in its tariffs; that the abandonment of Enwood station as a non-agency will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of applicant, the maintenance of this non-agency station is no longer necessary.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Enwood located on its Sacramento Division in Placer County and to eliminate said station name from its station records.
