OPINION and ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station at 28th and R Streets, Sacramento, on its Sacramento Division in Sacramento County.

Applicant alleges that the station herein proposed to be abandoned is located within the switching limits of Sacramento Station yard; that no freight business was transacted at said station during the yearly period ending February 28, 1926; that no passenger business was transacted at said station during the yearly period ending March 31, 1926, there being no passenger fares published in tariffs and applicable to said station; that the proposed abandonment of the non-agency station will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of the applicant, there is no further necessity for the maintenance of said non-agency station.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon

its non-agency station of 28th and R Streets, Sacramento, on its Sacramento Division in Sacramento County, and to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records.
