OPINION and ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency at Winery on the Placerville Branch of its Sacramento Division in Sacramento County.

Applicant alleges that the station herein proposed to be abandoned is located within the switching limits of its Sacramento Station yard; that no freight business has been handled at said station during the yearly period ending February, 1926; that no passenger business has been handled at said station during the yearly period ending March 31, 1926; that the abandonment of said station does not contemplate the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of the applicant, there is no longer any necessity for the continued maintenance of the non-agency station.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Winery on the Placerville Branch of its Sacramento Division in Sacramento County and to eliminate the name

of said non-agency station from its station records.
