WHEREAS, Vern Heliot, to whom the Railroad Commission, in its Decisions No.10596 and 10758, both issued on Application No.7801, and in Decision No.12325, issued on Application No.9172, granted authority to operate an automobile service for the transportation of passengers between Fresno and Auberry and certain intermediate points, and an automobile service for the transportation of freight between Fresno and Old Auberry and certain intermediate points, has advised the Commission, in writing, under date of March 30, 1926, that he has discontinued service.
