**ORIGINAL**

WHEREAS, E. I. Ryker, who operates an automobile service for the transportation of passengers and express between the towns of Angiola and Alpaugh, under authority of the Railroad Commission, as shown by Decision No. 11429, dated December 29, 1922, and issued on Application No. 8528, has advised the Commission, in writing, under date of June 23, 1926, that he desires to discontinue the service, having lost a large part of his revenue through failure to secure a renewal of his contract with the U. S. Government to transport U. S. mail.

Now, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that E. I. Ryker be, and he hereby is authorized to discontinue the automobile service hereinabove described on July 1, 1926, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to E. I. Ryker in Decision No. 11429 be and the same hereby is revoked, and annulled.
