SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Nativo Celayo, who operates an automobile service for the transportation of passengers and baggage between Angels Camp and Murphys and intermediate points, under authority of the Railroad Commission, as shown by Decision No.5906, dated May 12, 1918, and issued on Application No.4178, has advised the Commission, in writing, under date of June 29, 1926, that he desires to discontinue the service, having lost a large part of his revenue through failure to secure a renewal of his contract with the U.S. Government to transport U. S. mail.

Now, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Nativo Celayo be and he hereby is authorized to discontinue the automobile service hereinabove described on June 30, 1926, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Nativo Celayo in Decision No.5906 be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
