SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, this Commission on April 26, 1926, issued its Decision No. 16,576 in the above entitled proceeding, which decision authorized the Colusa County Telephone Company to charge certain rates for public pay station service and to make effective certain rules and regulations, providing said rates and rules and regulations were filed prior to June 1, 1926, and

WHEREAS, Colusa County Telephone Company was unable to file said rates and rules and regulations within the time authorized, and

WHEREAS, the Colusa County Telephone Company is desirous of charging said rate and making effective said rules and regulations as heretofore requested and there appearing no good reason why Colusa County Telephone Company should not charge said rates and make effective said rules and regulations,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Colusa County Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to charge and collect the rates for public pay station service and to make effective the

rules and regulations as set forth in the order of this Commission's Decision No. 16,576 for telephone service furnished on and after August 1, 1926, providing said rates and rules and regulations be submitted for filing with this Commission on or before July 30, 1926.
